

54 HOLE TOURNAMENT

FINALS

The 2010 finals for the St. Louis Metro Senior Golf Ass'n will be hosted by Mary Campbell & the Spencer T. Olin. Arnold Palmer designed golf course in Alton, IL.

New for 2010 will be the addition of Awards for each of the 4 flights such as Closest to Pin, Longest Drive and Individual Trophies along with the usual Prize money distribution.

54 HOLE TOURNAMENT

The 54 hole tournament is a tournament that is played along with our regular weekly division tournaments and is the sum of the scores for the designated courses. You will notice that these 3 courses are designated in the course schedule.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. A player must play in all three weeks of the scheduled 54 hole tournament and must have played five (5) official 18-hole tournaments prior to the start of the first of the three qualifying tournaments.
2. If a division is rained out, the player must play in the remaining tournaments to qualify.
3. There are four (4) winners in each flight, total of 16 players from each Division, Four (4) from A flight, four (4) from B flight, four (4) from C flight and four (4) from D flight. A total of 64 players will compete in the finals, but will compete with players within their respective Flight.
4. The total score of each player is totaled for the three tournaments (barring Rainouts) your handicap index at the start of the 54 hole tournament remains the same for all three weeks in determining who qualifies. However, your handicap index will change regarding payout of weekly Prize money.
5. Qualifying is determined by taking the two low gross and two low net scores from each flight from each division, which totals 64 players.
6. The people who qualify play a special tournament (54 Hole Finals) to determine the overall flight winners. This tournament is closed to everyone other than the players who have qualified.
